

Community Service involvement entails service projects and activities sanctioned by Altrusa, as documented in a Club's minutes.

Service hours include time spent in planning, preparation, execution and evaluation of fundraisers and service projects. Operating and internal fundraisers used to fund the operating budget do not qualify for any service hours.

Member Service Hours: Altrusa's member services include services such as production of newsletter, leadership training workshops, International representation at Conferences, etc.

Other Volunteer Hours: Club member participation in non-Altrusa community service activities, includes volunteer work. For example, in hospitals, schools, libraries, not-for-profit organizations and activities such as mentoring, tutoring, etc.

IMPORTANT: Do NOT duplicate your hours. If you are writing your attendance on a sheet at a group event, the host is tallying your hours at that event. Otherwise, turn in your OWN hours at the meetings and that can be monthly or quarterly. There is a Service Hour form on the home page of the website IF you choose to tally that way.

NOTE: ASTRA and New Club Building are service projects therefore does not count towards perfect attendance but does count in service hours.
